On 2 June 2022, we organised a day in nature in El Mato Permaculture Farm, where we organized activities to spread our knowledge about the methods and the benefits that permaculture and community gardens have for the society.

At our international Multiplier event , we had participants from 7 countries: Austria, Czech Republic, Germany, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal and Romania.

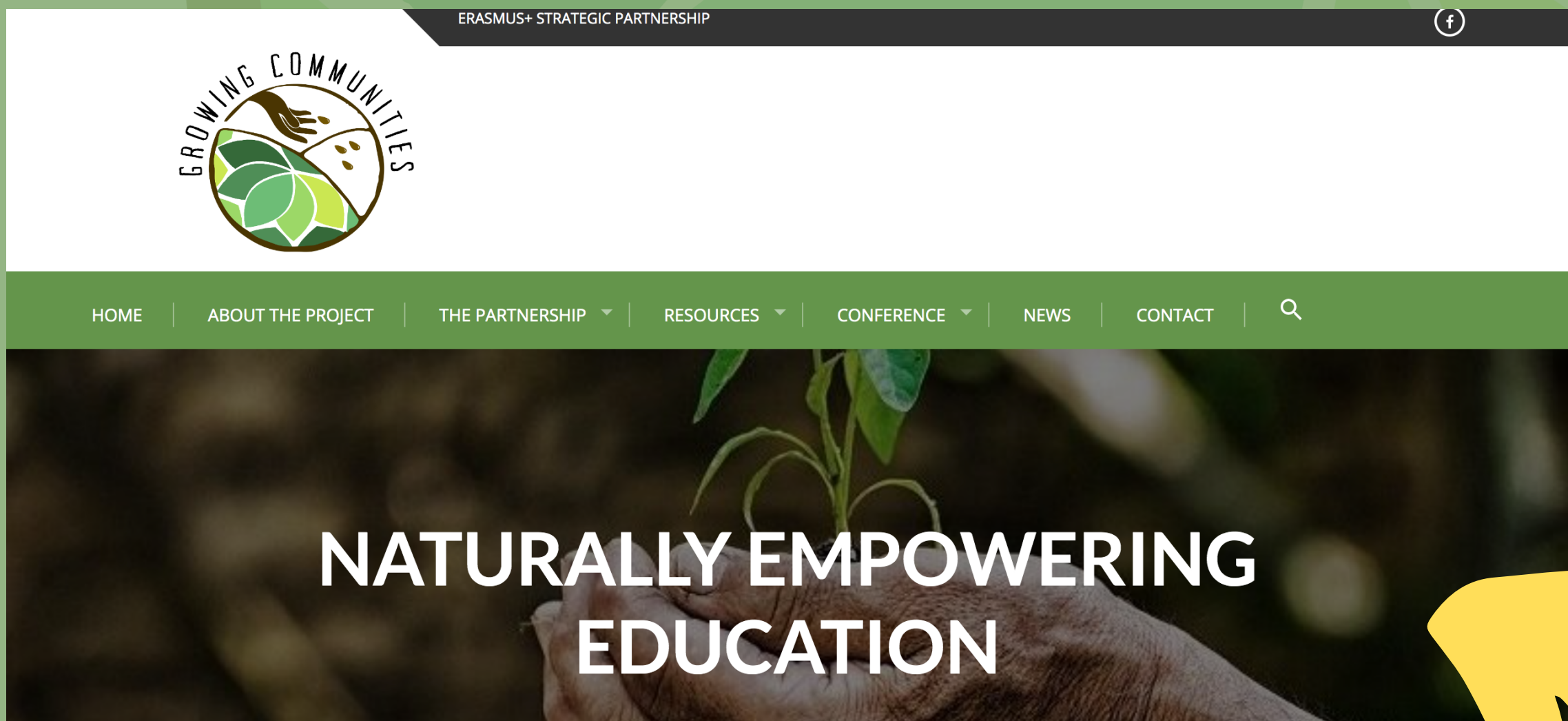
Our partners from Trial&Error and Dominou Association were also able to come.
